

Post-event clean up for events with registration

Here is how getting an event's registration closed and related clean-up works:

if your fsgw.org login has “eventadmin” group rights, then you will see a “Clean up registrations after event” button in eventcount. See the screenshot below. This button will close registration for the event and additionally will delete all unpaid, not checked-in registrations for the event, so the invoices will not sit around pointlessly and confusingly asking the contact to pay them.

Also for those with “eventadmin” rights, there is an “Only events that need clean up?” option checkbox for the “Go Back to Event List” button at the bottom of the page. See the screenshot below. With this option, doing event clean-up is easy. Set this option, display the event list, pick a displayed event, hit the clean up button, check that no complaints were displayed, and repeat until no events (needing clean-up) are displayed. Then uncheck this option.

There are a few warning messages that event clean-up can display about the status of individual registrations and their payments, which is why we did not make clean-up just run automatically. The conditions to cause those messages happen very infrequently, usually only from larger events with busier (more chaotic) check-in, for example Contraststock or hashdance. If you see any messages in orange or red from clean-up, email the event information and the messages to the treasurer, webmaster, and office.

The office staff are supposed to clean up all events needing it, at least weekly, but they can be variable about doing that, at times having gone almost 3 weeks.
